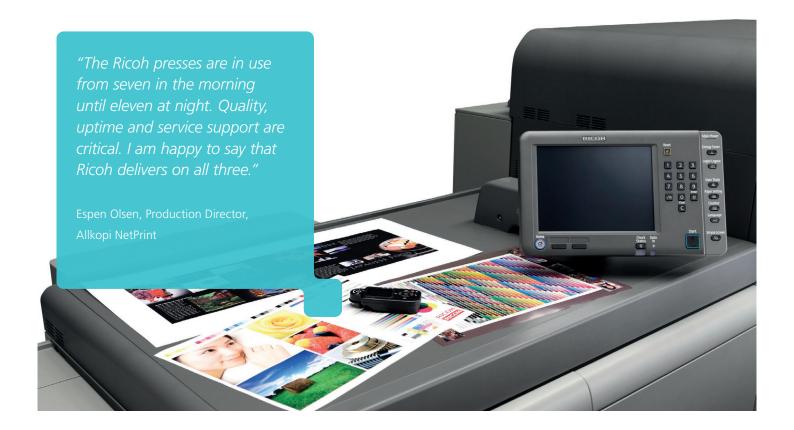

Flexible production platform

Three Ricoh Pro C9110 presses were installed in Allkopi NetPrint's production centre. Designed for non-stop use, each unit is capable of producing 130 colour impressions a minute and will print double-sided onto coated 400 gsm stock at full engine speed. To optimise production flexibility, the presses are equipped with a variety of finishing systems.

Professional inline CP Bourg and Plockmatic booklet making systems are used to finish the real estate brochures. Both systems produce saddle stitched booklets at the touch of a button. The high resolution brochure contents are automatically bound into full wrap heavyweight covers and trimmed on three sides for a full bleed finish.

Exceptional print quality

It was Espen Olsen, Allkopi NetPrint's production director, who made the decision to invest in Ricoh technology. He has not been disappointed.
